

Are you currently taking a Hydrocodone containing medication to help manage pain?



If so, please read the changes below as they will impact you and your prescription:

- The Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) announced on 08/22/2014 that all Hydrocodone containing products will change to a Schedule II controlled substance medication. This change becomes effective on 10/06/2014 and applies strict rules to the prescribing and dispensing of these medications.
- Any Hydrocodone medication will require a new prescription on an official prescription blank handwritten by your provider.
- Refills are not allowed on Schedule II controlled substance medications. A new handwritten prescription will be required every time you are prescribed a Hydrocodone medication.
- New prescriptions cannot be faxed or telephoned to the pharmacy.
- Maxor Mail Order will not be able to fill any prescriptions for these medications if the provider is not licensed in the state of Texas. For Mail Order customers with a provider outside the state of Texas, you will need to obtain your Hydrocodone prescription from your local Maxor or participating network pharmacy.
